25일까지 부산 벡스코(BEXCO)에서 열리는 '국제해양방위산업전(MADEX) 2019'에서 21세기 해군의 주력함들이 속속 대중 앞에 선보이고 있다. 11개국 160여 개 방산업체가 참여하고, 각국 해군참모 총장 등 26개국에서 80여 명의 외국군 대표단이 참가한 올해 전시회는 역대 최대 규모다.

국내 방산업체들은 해군이 도입하려고 하는 전투함들에 대한 모형과 그래픽을 준비했다. 대부분 아직 설계도 들어가지 않았기 때문에 업체의 제안이다. 그러나 업체가 나름 철저하게 준비한 만큼 단순한 상상은 아니라는 게 방산업계의 평가다.

한국 해양방위산업을 홍보하고 해외 방산업체와의 교류를 촉진할 2019 국제해양방위산업전 (MADEX)이 22일 부산 벡스코에서 개막했다.

올해로 11회째를 맞는 MADEX는 25일까지 나흘간 진행된다. 이번 전시회에는 11개국 160개 해양 방산업체들이 참여해 최첨단 함정무기체계와 함정·해양방위 시스템, 해양탐사선·특수선, 해양구조·구난장비 등을 선보인다.

한화시스템은 이번 전시회에서 통합마스트, 다기능레이다, 해양무인체계, 수중감시체계 등 차기구축함(KDDX)을 비롯한 미래 스마트 전투함정의 성능을 책임질 첨단 ICT 기술 기반의 최신 플랫폼들을 중점적으로 소개한다. 자체 개발한 무인수상정 아우라(AURA)를 비롯, 자율무인잠수정, 기뢰제거처리기 등 미래 해양무인시스템도 전시된다. LIG 넥스원도 전투체계와 다기능 능동위상배열레이더등을 선보인다. 미국 GE는 가스터빈을 비롯한 함정 동력체계를 전시할 예정이다.

Int'l maritime defense industry expo kicks off in S. Korea

SEOUL, Oct. 22 (Yonhap) -- A large-scale maritime defense exhibition opened in South Korea on Tuesday, featuring cutting-edge maritime defense systems from about 160 major defense firms around the world, the Navy said.

The international maritime defense industry exhibition, MADEX 2019, is scheduled to run through Friday at Bexco Exhibition Center in the country's southern city of Busan. The Navy organized the event along with the Busan city government and the Korea International Trade Association.

This year's event brought together some 160 major maritime defense companies from 11 countries to showcase state-of-the-art maritime defense systems, as well as diverse navigation, communication and safety equipment, by setting up around 380 booths to promote their products, according to the Navy.

On the sidelines of the exhibition, various meetings and seminars are planned to be attended by around 80 military leaders and experts from 26 countries, the Navy said, adding that its officers are scheduled to hold bilateral talks with their counterparts from 21 countries.

"The event is expected to serve as a chance for business entities to actively promote their products and for defense officials to boost maritime security cooperation with partner nations," a Navy officer said.

"Around 180 rounds of business meetings are expected to take place during the exhibition, which would lead to our defense exports worth US\$300 million," he added.

The MADEX defense fair was launched in 2001 and has been held biennially.

MADEX 2019: Integrated mast options emerge for Korea's KDDX

Models of two new integrated mast designs for South Korea's Next-Generation Destroyer (KDDX) programme were shown by LIG Nex1 and Hanwha Defense at the MADEX show in Busan.

The separately developed designs incorporate a range of sensors most prominently fixed X- and S-band multifunction radar arrays (MFRs) - and communications, electronic support measures, and electronic countermeasure system antennas within an enclosed mast structure.

Hanwha's design is an evolution of the integrated mast developed for the Republic of Korea Navy's (RoKN's) FFX Batch III frigate programme, while LIG Nex1's version is a clean sheet design.

Both MFR designs are based on Gallium Nitride (GaN) technologies, with LIG Nex1's using "GaN on Diamond" high electron mobility transistors.
